

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1**  
**OFFERED BY MS. PORTER OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 89, line 7, strike “sponsor” and insert “sponsor, unless the project sponsor has made lobbying or political expenditures, including expenditures paid or incurred in connection with direct communication with a covered executive branch official (as such term is defined in section 3 of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1602)) to influence the covered executive branch official’s actions or positions with respect to the proposed project, which are nondeductible under section 162(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986”.
