11	(A) in the matter before paragraph (1), by
12	striking "\$10,000,000" and inserting
13	"\$500,000"; and
14	(B) in paragraph (1), by striking "sub-
15	section (c)" and inserting "subsections (c) and
16	(d)(3)"; and
17	(3) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-
18	section (h); and

1	(4) by inserting after subsection (f) the fol-
2	lowing:
3	"(g) Failure to Disclose Certain Informa-
4	TION.—
5	"(1) In general.—It shall be unlawful for a
6	person to knowingly fail to—
7	"(A) submit information in accordance
8	with paragraph (1) of subsection (f); or
9	"(B) update such information in accord-
10	ance with paragraph (2) of such subsection.
11	"(2) Penalty.—A person who violates para-
12	graph (1) is subject to the following:
13	"(A) Entry of such violation in the data-
14	base established by subsection (a).
15	"(B) Imprisonment for not more than 5
16	years or a fine under title 18, United States
17	Code, or both.
18	"(C) A civil fine of not more than
19	\$200,000 per violation, depending on the extent
20	and gravity of the violation.
21	"(D) Liability pursuant to section 3729
22	title 31, United States Code.
23	"(E) Suspension and debarment.".
