Add at the end the following:

1 SEC. _. REPORT ON IRANIAN INTERNET CENSORSHIP.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
3 and the Secretary of State shall jointly submit to Congress
4 a report regarding Iranian internet censorship and appli5 cable United States licensing requirements. Such report
6 shall include the following:

7 (1) An assessment of the Iranian Government's
8 ability to impose internet shutdowns, censor the
9 internet, and track Iranian dissidents, labor orga10 nizers, political activists, or human rights defenders
11 inside Iran through targeted digital surveillance or
12 other digital means.

(2) An assessment of the impact of General License D-2, issued on September 23, 2022, on the
availability of private communications tools inside
Iran, including encryption tools to assist the people
of Iran in circumventing targeted digital surveillance
by the Iranian Government.

19 (3) A determination of whether additional up-20 dates to General License D-2 or other licenses are

needed to keep up with the pace of technology and
 ensure that United States restrictions do not unin tentionally inhibit the flow of vital communication
 tools to the people of Iran, including cloud tech nology, hardware, software, and services incident to
 personal communications, including set-top boxes
 (STB), satellites, and web developer tools.

8 (4) A strategy to ensure that resources are 9 available for digital rights experts to study Iran's 10 online repression and identify opportunities to 11 counter it.

(5) A strategy to prevent the Government of
Iran from acquiring or developing tools that could be
exploited against activists, including facial recognition software.

(b) FORM.—The report required pursuant to subsection (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form but may
include a classified annex if such annex is provided separately from such unclassified version.

(c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term "targeted
digital surveillance" means the use of items or services
that enable an individual or entity (with or without the
knowing authorization of the product's owner) to detect,
monitor, intercept, collect, exploit, preserve, protect, transmit, retain, or otherwise gain access to the communica-

- 1 tions, sensitive or protected information, work product,
- 2 browsing data, research, identifying information, location
- 3 history, or online or offline activities of other individuals,
- 4 organizations, or entities.
