

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-3
OFFERED BY MS. PRESSLEY OF MASSACHUSETTS**

Page 194, insert after line 15 the following:

1 **SEC. 1003. OFFICE ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN A DEP-**
2 **UTY DIRECTOR FOR LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY.**

3 Part T of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
4 Streets Act (34 U.S.C. 10441 et seq.), as amended by this
5 Act, is further amended by inserting after section 2004A
6 the following:

7 **“SEC. 2204B. DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY.**

8 “(a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—There is established in the
9 Office on Violence Against Women a Deputy Director for
10 LGBTQ+ Community.

11 “(b) **DUTIES.**—The Deputy Director shall, under the
12 guidance and authority of the Director of the Office on
13 Violence Against Women—

14 “(1) oversee the administration of grants re-
15 lated to lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender serv-
16 ices and contracts with organizations serving people
17 who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or
18 transgender;

19 “(2) coordinate development of Federal policy,
20 protocols, and guidelines on matters relating to do-

1 mestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and
2 stalking, impacting people who identify as lesbian,
3 gay, bisexual, or transgender;

4 “(3) advise the Director of the Office on Vio-
5 lence Against Women concerning policies, legislation,
6 implementation of laws, and other issues relating to
7 domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault,
8 and stalking impacting people who identify as les-
9 bian, gay, bisexual, or transgender;

10 “(4) provide technical assistance, coordination,
11 and support to other offices and bureaus in the De-
12 partment of Justice to develop policy and to enforce
13 Federal laws relating to domestic violence, dating vi-
14 olence, sexual assault, and stalking for people who
15 identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender;

16 “(5) ensure that appropriate technical assist-
17 ance, developed and provided by entities having ex-
18 pertise related to people who identify as lesbian, gay,
19 bisexual and transgender is made available to grant-
20 ees and potential grantees proposing to serve people
21 who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or
22 transgender; and

23 “(6) ensure access to grants and technical as-
24 sistance for organizations serving people who iden-
25 tify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender and

1 analyze the distribution of funding in order to iden-
2 tify barriers for organizations serving people who
3 identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgender.”.
