

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MS. PRESSLEY OF MASSACHUSETTS

Add at the end of subtitle C of title XVIII the following:

1 **SEC. 1859. UPDATED REPORT ON THE ASSASSINATION OF**
2 **HAITIAN PRESIDENT JOVENEL MOÏSE RE-**
3 **QUIRED BY THE HAITI DEVELOPMENT, AC-**
4 **COUNTABILITY, AND INSTITUTIONAL TRANS-**
5 **PARENCY INITIATIVE ACT OF 2022.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
8 in coordination with the Attorney General, the Secretary
9 of Homeland Security, and the Director of the Central In-
10 telligence Agency, shall submit to the Committee on For-
11 eign Relations of the Senate and the Committee on For-
12 eign Affairs of the House of Representatives an update
13 to the report on the July 7, 2021, assassination of former
14 President of Haiti Jovenel Moïse required under section
15 108(a) of the Haiti Development, Accountability, and In-
16 stitutional Transparency Initiative Act, 2022 (division V
17 of Public Law 117–103).

18 (b) ELEMENTS.—The update to the report required
19 under subsection (a) shall include the following:

1 (1) A detailed description of the events leading
2 up to the assassination of former President Jovenel
3 Moïse, and the subsequent investigation of the assas-
4 sination, including a description and identification of
5 key dates and the names of foreign persons related
6 to the assassination and the investigation of the as-
7 sassinatio.

8 (2) A description of United States support for
9 the efforts of Haitian authorities to investigate the
10 assassination of former President Jovenel Moïse.

11 (3) An assessment of the independence and ca-
12 pacity of Haitian authorities to investigate the as-
13 sassinatio of former President Jovenel Moïse, in-
14 cluding an analysis of significant advances and defi-
15 ciencies of the investigation.

16 (4) A description of any threats and acts of in-
17 timidation against Haitian law enforcement and ju-
18 dicial authorities involved in the investigation of the
19 assassination of former President Jovenel Moïse, in-
20 cluding the identification of foreign persons involved
21 in such threats and acts of intimidation.

22 (5) A description of any efforts to interfere in
23 or undermine the independence and integrity of the
24 investigation of the assassination of former Presi-
25 dent Jovenel Moïse.

1 (6) A description of whether any persons pre-
2 viously employed by or who served as a contractor
3 or informant for the United States Government were
4 involved in the assassination of former President
5 Jovenel Moïse.

6 (7) A description and the identification of for-
7 eign persons involved in the execution and planning
8 of the assassination of former President Jovenel
9 Moïse, and an assessment of the intentions of such
10 foreign persons.

11 (c) FORM OF REPORT.—The update to the report re-
12 quired under subsection (a) shall be submitted in unclassi-
13 fied form but may include a classified annex.

14 (d) PUBLICATION.—The Secretary of State shall post
15 on the public website of the Department of State the un-
16 classified version of the update to the report required
17 under subsection (a) not later than 15 days after the date
18 on which such update to such report is submitted under
19 such subsection.

20 (e) BRIEFING REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of
21 State, in coordination with the Attorney General, the Sec-
22 retary of Homeland Security, and the Director of the Cen-
23 tral Intelligence Agency, shall brief the Committee on For-
24 eign Relations of the Senate and the Committee on For-
25 eign Affairs of the House of Representatives on the con-
