

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MS. PRESSLEY OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of subtitle E of title VI, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6___. FEES CHARGED TO PARENTS FOR THE ATTEND-**
2 **ANCE OF CHILDREN AT MILITARY CHILD DE-**
3 **VELOPMENT CENTERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1793 of title 10, United
5 States Code, is amended as follows:

6 (1) In subsection (a)—

7 (A) by striking “family income.” and in-
8 serting “gross household income, regardless of
9 how many children of such household attend a
10 military child development center, as follows.”;
11 and

12 (B) by adding at the end the following new
13 paragraphs:

14 “(1) No such fee shall be charged to a house-
15 hold with a gross household income that does not ex-
16 ceed 85 percent of the median income of a house-
17 hold—

1 “(A) with the same number of individuals;
2 and

3 “(B) in the State in which the household
4 resides.

5 “(2) The total fees may not exceed two percent
6 of the gross household income in the case of a
7 household with a gross household income between 85
8 percent and 100 percent of the median income of a
9 household—

10 “(A) with the same number of individuals;
11 and

12 “(B) in the State in which such household
13 resides.

14 “(3) The total fees shall be more than two per-
15 cent, but may not exceed four percent, of the gross
16 household income in the case of a household with a
17 gross household income between 100 percent and
18 125 percent of the median income of a household—

19 “(A) with the same number of individuals;
20 and

21 “(B) in the State in which such household
22 resides.

23 “(4) The total fees shall be more than four per-
24 cent, but may not exceed seven percent, of the gross
25 household income in the case of a household with a

1 gross household income between 125 percent and
2 150 percent of the median income of a household—

3 “(A) with the same number of individuals;

4 and

5 “(B) in the State in which such household
6 resides.

7 “(5) The total fees shall equal seven percent of
8 the gross household income in the case of a house-
9 hold with a gross household income that exceeds 150
10 percent of the median income of a household—

11 “(A) with the same number of individuals;

12 and

13 “(B) in the State in which such household
14 resides.”.

15 (2) By striking subsection (c).

16 (b) DEFINITION.—Section 1800 of such title is
17 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
18 graph:

19 “(5) The term ‘gross household income’ has the
20 meaning given such term in section 402b of title
21 37.”.
