

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3438, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. PRICE OF GEORGIA**

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 **SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO**  
2 **IMPLEMENT EXECUTIVE ORDERS.**

3 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,  
4 and ending on January 21, 2017, no Federal funds, fees,  
5 or resources may be used to implement an Executive order  
6 which is issued on or after the date of the enactment of  
7 this Act.

8 **SEC. 4. SUSPENSION OF RULE MAKING AUTHORITY.**

9 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,  
10 and ending on January 21, 2017, no agency may finalize  
11 or engage in rule making relating to a rule that is—

12 (1) a major rule;

13 (2) a rule that may raise novel legal or policy  
14 issues arising out of legal mandates, the President's  
15 priorities, or the principles set forth in Executive  
16 Order 12866 (58 Fed. Reg. 190); or

17 (3) a rule that may create a serious inconsist-  
18 ency or otherwise interfere with an action taken or  
19 planned by another agency.

1 **SEC. 5. RESTRICTION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO**  
2 **IMPLEMENT PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMA-**  
3 **TIONS.**

4 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,  
5 and ending on January 21, 2017, no Federal funds, fees,  
6 or resources may be used to implement a declaration of  
7 a national monument by the President under section  
8 320301(a) of title 54, United States Code, made on or  
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

10 **SEC. 6. DEFINITIONS.**

11 For purposes of sections 3 and 4 of this Act:

12 (1) The term “agency” has the meaning given  
13 such term in section 551 of title 5, United States  
14 Code.

15 (2) The term “major rule” has the meaning  
16 given such term in section 804 of title 5, United  
17 States Code.

18 (3) The term “rule making” has the meaning  
19 given such term in section 551 of title 5, United  
20 States Code.
