Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO2IMPLEMENT EXECUTIVE ORDERS.

Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
and ending on January 21, 2017, no Federal funds, fees,
or resources may be used to implement an Executive order
which is issued on or after the date of the enactment of
this Act.

8 SEC. 4. SUSPENSION OF RULE MAKING AUTHORITY.

9 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
10 and ending on January 21, 2017, no agency may finalize
11 or engage in rule making relating to a rule that is—

12 (1) a major rule;

(2) a rule that may raise novel legal or policy
issues arising out of legal mandates, the President's
priorities, or the principles set forth in Executive
Order 12866 (58 Fed. Reg. 190); or

17 (3) a rule that may create a serious inconsist18 ency or otherwise interfere with an action taken or
19 planned by another agency.

1SEC. 5. RESTRICTION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO2IMPLEMENT3TIONS.

Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
and ending on January 21, 2017, no Federal funds, fees,
or resources may be used to implement a declaration of
a national monument by the President under section
320301(a) of title 54, United States Code, made on or
after the date of the enactment of this Act.

10 SEC. 6. DEFINITIONS.
