

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 114-64

OFFERED BY MR. PRICE OF GEORGIA

Page 6, line 4, add at the end before the period the following: “or the restrictions in section 10”.

Add at the end the following new section:

1 SEC. 10. RESTRICTIONS ON PAYMENTS TO STATE SPON-
2 SORS OF TERRORISM AND PERSONS SUBJECT
3 TO SANCTIONS ADMINISTERED BY THE OF-
4 FICE OF FOREIGN ASSETS CONTROL.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State may not
6 make a payment, or enter into an agreement to make a
7 payment, in settlement of a claim or judgment against the
8 United States made by a court of a foreign country or
9 a court established pursuant to an international agree-
10 ment to which the United States is a party, to—

11 (1) an agency or instrumentality of a govern-
12 ment of a state sponsor of terrorism, or an agent
13 acting on behalf of such a government; or

14 (2) a person that is subject to sanctions admin-
15 istered by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of
16 the Department of the Treasury under any of parts

1 501 through 598 of title 31, Code of Federal Regu-
2 lations.

3 (b) STATE SPONSOR OF TERRORISM DEFINED.—In
4 this section, the term “state sponsor of terrorism” means
5 a country the government of which the Secretary of State
6 has determined, for purposes of section 6(j)(1)(A) of the
7 Export Administration Act of 1979 (50 U.S.C. App.
8 2405(j)(1)(A)) (as continued in effect pursuant to the
9 International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50
10 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.)), section 620A(a) of the Foreign As-
11 sistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371(a)), section 40(d)
12 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780(d)), or
13 any other provision of law, to be a government that has
14 repeatedly provided support for acts of international ter-
15 rorism.
