Page 6, line 4, add at the end before the period the following: "or the restrictions in section 10".

Add at the end the following new section:

## 1SEC. 10. RESTRICTIONS ON PAYMENTS TO STATE SPON-2SORS OF TERRORISM AND PERSONS SUBJECT3TO SANCTIONS ADMINISTERED BY THE OF-4FICE OF FOREIGN ASSETS CONTROL.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State may not 6 make a payment, or enter into an agreement to make a 7 payment, in settlement of a claim or judgment against the 8 United States made by a court of a foreign country or 9 a court established pursuant to an international agree-10 ment to which the United States is a party, to—

(1) an agency or instrumentality of a government of a state sponsor of terrorism, or an agent
acting on behalf of such a government; or

(2) a person that is subject to sanctions administered by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of
the Department of the Treasury under any of parts

501 through 598 of title 31, Code of Federal Regu lations.

3 (b) STATE SPONSOR OF TERRORISM DEFINED.—In this section, the term "state sponsor of terrorism" means 4 5 a country the government of which the Secretary of State has determined, for purposes of section 6(j)(1)(A) of the 6 Export Administration Act of 1979 (50 U.S.C. App. 7 8 2405(j)(1)(A) (as continued in effect pursuant to the 9 International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.)), section 620A(a) of the Foreign As-10 11 sistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371(a)), section 40(d) of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780(d)), or 12 any other provision of law, to be a government that has 13 repeatedly provided support for acts of international ter-14 rorism. 15
