(b) Title I of the Labor-Management Reporting and
Disclosure Act of 1959 (29 U.S.C. 411 et seq.) is amended
by adding at the end the following:

4 "SEC. 106. RIGHT NOT TO SUBSIDIZE UNION NON-REP-5 RESENTATIONAL ACTIVITIES.

6 "No employee's union dues, fees, or assessments or 7 other contributions shall be used or contributed to any 8 person, organization, or entity for any purpose not directly 9 related to the labor organization's collective bargaining or 10 contract administration functions on behalf of the rep-11 resented unit employee unless the employee member, or 12 nonmember required to make such payments as a condition of employment, authorizes such expenditure in writ-13 14 ing, after a notice period of not less than 35 days. An initial authorization provided by an employee under the 15 preceding sentence shall expire not later than 1 year after 16 the date on which such authorization is signed by the em-17

- 1 ployee. There shall be no automatic renewal of an author-
- 2 ization under this section.".
