

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116–57
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of title XVII, insert the following new subtitle:

1 **Subtitle F—Protecting Academic**
2 **Integrity Act**

3 **SEC. 1771. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This subtitle may be cited as the “Protecting Aca-
5 demic Integrity Act”.

6 **SEC. 1772. DISCLOSURE OF FOREIGN GIFTS.**

7 (a) VALUE OF GIFTS.—Section 117(a) of the Higher
8 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1011f(a)) is amended
9 by striking “\$250,000” and inserting “\$50,000”.

10 (b) CONTENTS OF REPORT.—Section 117(b) of the
11 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1011f(b)) is
12 amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (2), by inserting “and, when
14 available, the specific department, agency, office, or
15 division of the foreign government responsible for
16 the gift or contract” before the period at the end;

17 (2) in paragraph (3), by inserting “and, when
18 available, the specific department, agency, office, or

1 division of the foreign government responsible for
2 the gift or contract” before the period at the end;
3 and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(4) If available, the purpose or intention of a
6 foreign gift or contract. If no purpose or intention
7 is identified with respect to the gift or contract, the
8 institution shall report the intended use of such gift
9 or contract and the account or the department of
10 such institution that will receive such gift or con-
11 tract.”.

12 (c) **ADDITIONAL DISCLOSURES FOR RESTRICTED**
13 **AND CONDITIONAL GIFTS.**—Section 117(c)(2) of the
14 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1011f(c)(2))
15 is amended by inserting “and, when available, the specific
16 department, agency, office, or division of the foreign gov-
17 ernment responsible for the gift or contract” before the
18 period at the end.

19 (d) **APPLICABILITY.**—This section and the amend-
20 ments made by this section shall take effect on the date
21 that is 1 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.

22 **SEC. 1773. GAO STUDY AND REPORT.**

23 (a) **STUDY.**—The Comptroller General of the United
24 States shall carry out a study on—

1 (1) the extent to which institutions of higher
2 education comply with—

3 (A) the requirements of section 117 of the
4 Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
5 1011f); and

6 (B) the regulations issued pursuant to
7 such section;

8 (2) in the case of institutions of higher edu-
9 cation that fail to comply with such requirements,
10 the reasons for the failure of such institutions of
11 higher education to comply;

12 (3) the extent to which institutions of higher
13 education attempt to correct a failure to comply with
14 such requirements; and

15 (4) the Federal efforts to increase compliance
16 with such requirements.

17 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
18 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
19 the United States shall submit to Congress a report that
20 includes the results of the study conducted under sub-
21 section (a).
