## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**19**

## OFFERED BY MR. QUIGLEY OF ILLINOIS

At the end of subtitle C of title VII, add the following new provision:

1	SEC. 7 PILOT PROGRAM ON PARTNERSHIPS WITH CI-
2	VILIAN ORGANIZATIONS FOR SPECIALIZED
3	SURGICAL TRAINING.
4	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Defense shall
5	carry out a pilot program to establish one or more partner-
6	ships with public, private, and non-profit organizations
7	and institutions to provide short-term specialized surgical
8	training to advance the medical skills and capabilities of
9	military medical providers.
10	(b) Duration.—The Secretary may carry out the
11	pilot program under subsection (a) for a period of not
12	more than three years.
13	(c) EVALUATION METRICS.—Before commencing the
14	pilot program under subsection (a), the Secretary shall es-
15	tablish metrics to be used to evaluate the effectiveness of
16	the pilot program.
17	(d) Reports.—
18	(1) Initial report.—

1	(A) In general.—Not later than 180
2	days before the commencement of the pilot pro-
3	gram under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
4	submit to the Committees on Armed Services of
5	the Senate and the House of Representatives a
6	report on the pilot program.
7	(B) Elements.—The report required by
8	subparagraph (A) shall include a description of
9	the pilot program, the evaluation metrics estab-
10	lished under subsection (c), and such other
11	matters relating to the pilot program as the
12	Secretary considers appropriate.
13	(2) Final Report.—
14	(A) In general.—Not later than 180
15	days after the completion of the pilot program
16	under subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit
17	to the Committees on Armed Services of the
18	Senate and the House of Representatives a re-
19	port on the pilot program.
20	(B) Elements.—The report required by
21	subparagraph (A) shall include the following:
22	(i) A description of the pilot program,
23	including the partnerships established
24	under the pilot program as described in
25	subsection (a).

1	(ii) An assessment of the effectiveness
2	of the pilot program.
3	(iii) Such recommendations for legis-
4	lative or administrative action as the Sec-
5	retary considers appropriate in light of the
6	pilot program, including recommendations
7	for extending or making permanent the au-
8	thority for the pilot program.
9	(e) Funding.—
10	(1) Increase.—Notwithstanding the amounts
11	set forth in the funding tables in division D, the
12	amount authorized to be appropriated in section
13	1405 for the Defense Health Program, as specified
14	in the corresponding funding table in section 4501,
15	for education and training is hereby increased by
16	\$2,500,000.
17	(2) Offset.—Notwithstanding the amounts set
18	forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount
19	authorized to be appropriated in section 1405 for
20	Defense Health Program, Operation and Mainte-
21	nance, Private Sector Care, Office of the Secretary
22	of Defense, as specified in the corresponding funding
23	table in section 4501, is hereby reduced by
24	\$2,500,000.
