OFFERED BY MR. QUIGLEY OF ILLINOIS

Page 1365, after line 22, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . LAW ENFORCEMENT ATTACHE DEPLOYMENT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning in fiscal year 2021, the
3 Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Director of
4 the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, in consulta-
5 tion with the Secretary of State, shall require the Chief
6 of Law Enforcement of the United States Fish and Wild-
7 life Service to hire, train, and deploy not fewer than 50
8 new United States Fish and Wildlife Service law enforce-
9 ment attachés, and appropriate additional support staff,
10 at one or more United States embassies, consulates, com-
11 mands, or other facilities—

12 (1) in one or more countries designated as a
13 focus country or a country of concern in the most
14 recent report submitted under section 201 of the
15 Eliminate, Neutralize, and Disrupt Wildlife Traf-
16 ficking Act of 2016 (16 U.S.C. 7621); and

17 (2) in such additional countries or regions, as
18 determined by the Secretary of Interior, that are

1 known or suspected to be a source of illegal trade of
2 species listed—

3 (A) as threatened species or endangered
4 species under the Endangered Species Act of
5 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.); or

6 (B) under appendix I of the Convention on
7 International Trade in Endangered Species of
8 Wild Fauna and Flora, done at Washington
9 March 3, 1973 (27 UST 1087; TIAS 8249); or

10 (C) on the International Union for the
11 Conservation of Nature's Red List of Threat-
12 ened Species.

13 (b) FUNDING.—There is authorized to be appro-
14 priated to carry out this section \$150,000,000 for each
15 of fiscal years 2021 through 2030.
