PARK DISTRICT COMMUNITY SUPPORT GRANT 2 PROGRAM. 3 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: 4 (1) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—The term "eligible enti-5 ty" means a special purpose district, including park 6 districts. (2) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means 7 8 the Secretary of the Interior. 9 (b) GRANTS AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary shall es-10 tablish an Park District Community Support grant pro-11 gram under which the Secretary may award grants to eli-12 gible entities for projects— 13 (1) to maintain land and water for parks and 14 other outdoor recreation purposes; (2) to operate new or renovate existing outdoor 15 16 recreation facilities; and 17 (3) to build, operate, maintain, or refurbish in-18 door or outdoor facilities owned or partly owned or 2

1	operated by a Park District and used by or to sup-
2	port the public, and for other purposes.
3	(c) MATCHING REQUIREMENT.—
4	(1) IN GENERAL.—As a condition of receiving a
5	grant under subsection (a), an eligible entity shall
6	provide matching funds in the form of cash or an in-
7	kind contribution in an amount equal to not less
8	than 100 percent of the amounts made available
9	under the grant.
10	(2) Sources.—The matching amounts referred
11	to in paragraph (1) may include amounts made
12	available from State, local, nongovernmental, or pri-
13	vate sources.
14	(3) WAIVER.—The Secretary may waive all or
15	part of the matching requirement under paragraph
16	(1) if the Secretary determines that—
17	(A) no reasonable means are available
18	through which an applicant can meet the
19	matching requirement; and
20	(B) the probable benefit of such project
21	outweighs the public interest in such matching
22	requirement.
23	(d) Authorization of Appropriations.—There
24	are authorized to be appropriated \$100,000,000 to the

- 2 Support Grant Program.
