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OFFERED BY MR. QUIGLEY OF ILLINOIS

Add at the end the following new title:

1 **TITLE IV—LAW ENFORCEMENT**

2 **ATTACHE DEPLOYMENT**

3 **SEC. 71101. LAW ENFORCEMENT ATTACHE DEPLOYMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning in fiscal year 2023, the
5 Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Director of
6 the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, in consulta-
7 tion with the Secretary of State, shall require the Chief
8 of Law Enforcement of the United States Fish and Wild-
9 life Service to hire, train, and deploy not fewer than 50
10 new United States Fish and Wildlife Service law enforce-
11 ment attaches, and appropriate additional support staff,
12 at one or more United States embassies, consulates, com-
13 mands, or other facilities—

14 (1) in one or more countries designated as a
15 focus country or a country of concern in the most
16 recent report submitted under section 201 of the
17 Eliminate, Neutralize, and Disrupt Wildlife Traf-
18 ficking Act of 2016 (16 U.S.C. 7621); and

1 (2) in such additional countries or regions, as
2 determined by the Secretary of Interior, that are
3 known or suspected to be a source of illegal trade of
4 species listed—

5 (A) as threatened species or endangered
6 species under the Endangered Species Act of
7 1973 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.); or

8 (B) under appendix I of the Convention on
9 International Trade in Endangered Species of
10 Wild Fauna and Flora, done at Washington
11 March 3, 1973 (27 UST 1087; TIAS 8249).

12 (b) FUNDING.—There is authorized to be appro-
13 priated to carry out this section \$150,000,000 for each
14 of fiscal years 2023 through 2032.
