## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–36

## OFFERED BY MRS. RADEWAGEN OF AMERICAN SAMOA

At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following:

1	SEC. 5 FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A UNIT OF THE
2	NATIONAL GUARD IN AMERICAN SAMOA AND
3	IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN
4	MARIANA ISLANDS.
5	(a) Determination Required.—The Secretary of
6	Defense shall determine the feasibility of establishing—
7	(1) a unit of the National Guard in American
8	Samoa; and
9	(2) a unit of the National Guard in the Com-
10	monwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
11	(b) Force Structure Elements.—In making the
12	feasibility determination under subsection (a), the Sec-
13	retary of Defense shall consider the following:
14	(1) The allocation of National Guard force
15	structure and manpower to American Samoa and
16	the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands
17	in the event of the establishment of a unit of the
18	National Guard in American Samoa and in the

Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands,
and the impact of this allocation on existing Na-
tional Guard units in the 50 States, the Common-
wealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam,
and the District of Columbia.
(2) The Federal funding that would be required
to support pay, benefits, training operations, and
missions of members of a unit of the National Guard
in American Samoa and the Commonwealth of the
Northern Mariana Islands, based on the allocation
derived from paragraph (1), and the equipment, in-
cluding maintenance, required to support such force
structure.
(3) The presence of existing infrastructure to
support a unit of the National Guard in American
Samoa and the Commonwealth of the Northern
Mariana Islands, and the requirement for additional
infrastructure, including information technology in-
frastructure, to support such force structure, based
on the allocation derived from paragraph (1).
(4) How a unit of the National Guard in Amer-
ican Samoa and the Commonwealth of the Northern
Mariana Island would accommodate the National
Guard Bureau's "Essential Ten" homeland defense

capabilities (i.e., aviation, engineering, civil support

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1	teams, security, medical, transportation, mainte-
2	nance, logistics, joint force headquarters, and com-
3	munications) and reflect regional needs.
4	(5) The manpower cadre, both military per-
5	sonnel and fulltime support, including National
6	Guard technicians, required to establish, maintain,
7	and sustain a unit of the National Guard in Amer-
8	ican Samoa and the Commonwealth of the Northern
9	Mariana Islands, and the ability of American Samoa
10	and of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana
11	Islands to support demographically a unit of the Na-
12	tional Guard at each location.
13	(6) The ability of a unit of the National Guard
14	in American Samoa and the Commonwealth of the
15	Northern Mariana Islands to maintain unit readi-
16	ness and the logistical challenges associated with
17	transportation, communications, supply/ resupply,
18	and training operations and missions.
19	(c) Submission of Conclusion.—Not later than
20	180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
21	Secretary of Defense shall notify the congressional defense
22	committees of the results of the feasibility determination
23	made under subsection (a). If the Secretary determines
24	that establishment of a unit of the National Guard in
25	American Samoa or the Commonwealth of the Northern

1	Mariana Islands (or both) is feasible, the Secretary shall
2	include in the notification the following:
3	(1) A determination of whether the executive
4	branch of American Samoa and of the Common-
5	wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands has enacted
6	and implemented statutory authorization for an or-
7	ganized militia as a prerequisite for establishing a
8	unit of the National Guard, and a description of any
9	other steps that such executive branches must take
10	to request and carry out the establishment of a Na-
11	tional Guard unit.
12	(2) A list of any amendments to titles 10, 32,
13	and 37, United States Code, that would have to be
14	enacted by Congress to provide for the establishment
15	of a unit of the National Guard in American Samoa
16	and in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana
17	Islands.
18	(3) A description of any required Department
19	of Defense actions to establish a unit of the National
20	Guard in American Samoa and in the Common-
21	wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
22	(4) A suggested timeline for completion of the
23	steps and actions described in the preceding para-
24	graphs.
