

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–**

**OFFERED BY MRS. RAMIREZ OF ILLINOIS**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 17\_\_\_ REPORT BY THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF-**  
**2 FAIRS ON CERTAIN INFORMATION RELATED**  
**3 TO THE UNITED STATES DOGE SERVICE.**

4 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
5 of the enactment of this section, the Secretary of Veterans  
6 Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-  
7 fairs of the House of Representatives and the Senate a  
8 report containing any document, record, report, memo-  
9 randa, correspondence, audio recording, call log, activity  
10 log, audit trail, audit log, notes from meetings, written  
11 agreement, or other communication, or portion of such  
12 communication, in the possession or control of the Sec-  
13 retary, that refers or relates to the following:

14 (1) Any policy, directive, or guidance from  
15 DOGE to the Secretary relating to management of  
16 employees of the Department, including any termi-  
17 nation, reduction in force, or plan for reorganization.

1           (2) Any policy, directive, or guidance from  
2       DOGE to the Secretary relating to an agreement be-  
3       tween the Secretary and a non-Federal entity, in-  
4       cluding—

5           (A) any termination or recompetes of a con-  
6       tract;

7           (B) any disposal or sale of Department  
8       property; or

9           (C) any freeze or change in funding to a  
10      grantee.

11       (3) Any data system of the Department—

12           (A) that has been accessed or edited by  
13      DOGE; or

14           (B) from which DOGE has removed or  
15      copied data.

16   (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

17       (1) The term “Department property” has the  
18      meaning given such term in section 901 of title 38,  
19      United States Code.

20       (2) The term “DOGE” means the United  
21      States DOGE Service, commonly referred to as the  
22      “Department of Government Efficiency”.
