At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following new section:

13	toration Act of 2025, in which the educational insti-
14	tution was not approved by a State approving agen-
15	cy or the Secretary acting as a State approving
16	agency, including periods in which an educational in-
17	stitution is not approved because an approval is re-
18	voked.
19	"(2) Any period, occurring on or after the date
20	of enactment of the Student Veteran Benefit Res-
21	toration Act of 2025, with regards to which the Sec-
22	retary has made a final determination that the edu-
23	cational institution, or the owner of the educational
24	institution, was in violation during such period of an
25	applicable provision of section 3696 of this title.

1	"(3) Any period, occurring on or after the date
2	of enactment of the Student Veteran Benefit Res-
3	toration Act of 2025, during which a court of com-
4	petent jurisdiction found the educational institution
5	guilty of, or liable for, fraud.
6	"(4) Any period, occurring on or after the date
7	of enactment of the Student Veteran Benefit Res-
8	toration Act of 2025, during which the educational
9	institution was closed by the Department of Justice
10	on the basis of fraud or a violation of a provision of
11	Federal or State law.
12	"(5) Any period occurring on or after the date
13	of enactment of the Student Veteran Benefit Res-
14	toration Act of 2025—
15	"(A) during which the educational institu-
16	tion engaged in fraud; and
17	"(B) after which the educational institu-
18	tion closes.
19	"(c) Repayment of Funds.—(1) As a condition of
20	the approval of a course or program of education under
21	this chapter, the educational institution offering the
22	course or program shall agree that if the educational insti-
23	tution receives payment of covered educational assistance
24	for a covered individual to pursue a course or program
25	of education at the educational institution and the Sec-

- 8 "(2) In the case of an educational institution that has
- 9 been found guilty of, or liable for, fraud by a court of com-
- 10 petent jurisdiction and is ordered to pay financial relief
- 11 to the Federal Government, the Secretary may file a claim
- 12 with the Department of the Treasury for recoupment of
- 13 all amounts of educational assistance received by such
- 14 educational institution pursuant to the educational assist-
- 15 ance programs administered by the Secretary that the
- 16 Secretary determines were obtained through such fraud.
- 17 "(d) Appeals.—(1) The Secretary shall establish a
- 18 process by which an educational institution or the owner
- 19 of an educational institution that is subject to a finding
- 20 by the Secretary that the educational institution is re-
- 21 quired to repay an amount under subsection (c) may re-
- 22 quest a review of such finding.
- 23 "(2) The process established pursuant to paragraph
- 24 (1) shall be distinct and separate from the process estab-
- 25 lished under section 3696(i) of this title.

1	"(e) Definitions.—In this section:
2	"(1) The term 'covered educational assistance'
3	means educational assistance under chapter 30, 31,
4	32, 33, or 35 of this title, or chapter 1606 or 1607
5	of title 10.
6	"(2) The term 'covered individual' means a vet-
7	eran or other individual using covered educational
8	assistance to pursue a course or program of edu-
9	cation that has been approved under this chapter.
10	"(3) The term 'fraud' means fraud or another
11	false, misleading, or deceptive act or omission.".
12	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
13	at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
14	after the item relating to section 3699B the following new
15	item:
	"3699C. Restoration of entitlement for pursuit of courses or programs of edu-
