

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT****119–8****OFFERED BY MS. RANDALL OF WASHINGTON**

At the appropriate place in subtitle F of title XXVIII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 28\_\_\_ . FFRDC STUDY ON MULTI-MODAL TRANSPOR-**  
2 **TATION AND TRAIL INFRASTRUCTURE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall  
4 seek to enter into an agreement with a federally funded  
5 research and development center under which such center  
6 shall complete a study on how multi-modal transportation  
7 projects, including bike and pedestrian trails, public tran-  
8 sit connections, and other active transportation infrastruc-  
9 ture, can improve access to military installations and sup-  
10 port defense community needs.

11 (b) ELEMENTS.—The study under subsection (a)  
12 shall—

13 (1) assess the role of multi-modal transpor-  
14 tation in reducing congestion, improving installation  
15 accessibility, and supporting personnel recruitment,  
16 retention, and quality of life;

17 (2) evaluate health, safety, and environmental  
18 benefits for surrounding defense communities;

1           (3) identify best practices for incorporating  
2       multi-modal transportation projects into under the  
3       Defense Community Infrastructure Program  
4       (DCIP); and

5           (4) consider how those findings of such assess-  
6       ment informed the creation of the DCIP.

7       (c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date  
8       of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit  
9       to the Committees on Armed Services of the House of  
10      Representatives and the Senate a report that includes the  
11      findings of the study under subsection (a).
