Insert, at the appropriate place, the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . REQUIREMENTS TO IMPROVE DETENTION CON-**
2 **DITIONS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Director of U.S. Immigration
4 and Customs Enforcement shall improve the conditions of
5 detention for individuals in the custody of U.S. Immigra-
6 tion and Customs Enforcement by providing—

7 (1) free or low cost phone and video visits;

8 (2) submitting to law enforcement investiga-
9 tions into allegations of violence by officers and em-
10 ployees of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-
11 ment facility;

12 (3) “Know your rights” presentations on a
13 monthly basis at all U.S. Immigration and Customs
14 Enforcement facilities;

15 (4) access to legal counsel, including providing
16 additional rooms for meetings between legal counsel
17 and such individuals;

18 (5) laundry services not less than twice a week
19 and providing a minimum of 8 pairs of underwear
20 for each such individual; and

1 (6) unlimited menstrual products to female de-
2 tainees.

3 (b) IMPROVEMENTS.—The Director of U.S. Immigra-
4 tion and Customs Enforcement shall take such steps as
5 may be necessary to improve access to and the process
6 relating to privacy release forms to be signed by an indi-
7 vidual in the custody of the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
8 rity.

9 (c) RESPONSE REQUIRED.—The Director of U.S. Im-
10 migration and Customs Enforcement shall respond to any
11 Congressional inquiry within 30 days from the date of
12 such inquiry.
