2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 758 of title 18, United

4 "§ 758. Fleeing enforcement of immigration laws

5 "Whoever—

6 "(1) flees or evades a Federal, State, or local 7 law enforcement officer, which officer has identified 8 himself as such an officer. enforcing section 9 274(a)(1)(A)(i) or (ii), section 274(a)(2), section 10 275, section 276, or section 277 of the Immigration 11 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1324, 1325, 1326, 12 1327); or

"(2) flees or evades a checkpoint operated by
the Immigration and Naturalization Service, or any
other Federal law enforcement agency, and flees
Federal, State, or local law enforcement agents,

17 shall be fined under this title, imprisoned not more than18 five years, or both, or, in the case of flight or evasion in19 motor vehicle in excess of the legal speed limit, shall be

fined under this title, imprisoned not more than 8 years,
 or both.".

3 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
4 for chapter 35 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
5 by striking the item related to section 758 and inserting
6 the following:

"758. Fleeing enforcement of immigration laws.".
