"(B) the receipt of new information reveal-5 6 ing effects of the previously issued land man-7 agement plan decision that may affect a listed 8 species or designated critical habitat in a man-9 ner or to an extent not previously considered, 10 provided that any authorized actions subject to 11 that land management plan for which the new 12 information is relevant will be addressed 13 through a separate action-specific consultation. 14 "(2) RELATION TO OTHER LAWS.—Nothing in 15 this subparagraph shall affect or modify the requirements of section 219 of title 36, Code of Federal 16 17 Regulations, or section 1600 of title 543, Code of 18 Federal Regulations.".
