At the end of subtitle A of title VII, add the following:

1	SEC GAO REPORT ON MASS FLIGHT CANCELLATION
2	EVENT.
3	(a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 1 year after
4	the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
5	of the United States shall submit to the Committee on
6	Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-
7	resentatives and the Committee on Commerce, Science,
8	and Transportation of the Senate a report on the actions
9	of the Department of Transportation during the period be-
10	ginning 2 weeks before July 4th, 2023, and ending two
11	weeks after July 4th, 2023, that resulted in substantial
12	flight calculations during such period.
13	(b) Examination.—In developing the report under
14	subsection (a), the Comptroller general shall examine—
15	(1) all actions the Secretary of Transportation
16	and the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Ad-
17	ministration took to mitigate flight disruptions and
18	flight cancellations during such period; and

1	(2) any actions not taken by the Secretary or
2	the Administrator that may have mitigated flight
3	disruptions and cancellations during such period.
