At the end of title XI, add the following:

1 SEC. 11____. REPORTING REQUIREMENT.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7131 of title 5, United
3 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing:

5 "(e)(1)(A) Not later than March 31 of each calendar
6 year, the Office of Personnel Management, in consultation
7 with the Office of Management and Budget, shall submit
8 to each House of Congress a report on the operation of
9 this section during the fiscal year last ending before the
10 start of such calendar year.

"(B) Not later than December 31 of each calendar
year, each agency (as defined by section 7103(a)(3)) shall
furnish to the Office of Personnel Management the information which such Office requires, with respect to such
agency, for purposes of the report which is next due under
subparagraph (A).

17 "(2) Each report by the Office of Personnel Manage-18 ment under this subsection shall include, with respect to

1 the fiscal year described in paragraph (1)(A), at least the2 following information:

- 3 "(A) The total amount of official time granted4 to employees.
- 5 "(B) The average amount of official time ex-6 pended per bargaining unit employee.
- 7 "(C) The specific types of activities or purposes
 8 for which official time was granted, and the impact
 9 which the granting of such official time for such ac10 tivities or purposes had on agency operations.
- 11 "(D) The total number of employees to whom 12 official time was granted, and, of that total, the 13 number who were not engaged in any activities or 14 purposes except activities or purposes involving the 15 use of official time.
- "(E) The total amount of compensation (including fringe benefits) afforded to employees in connection with activities or purposes for which they were
 granted official time.
- "(F) The total amount of official time spent by
 employees representing Federal employees who are
 not union members in matters authorized by this
 chapter.

24 "(G) A description of any room or space des-25 ignated at the agency (or its subcomponent) where

1	official time activities will be conducted, including
2	the square footage of any such room or space.
3	"(3) All information included in a report by the Of-
4	fice of Personnel Management under this subsection with
5	respect to a fiscal year—
6	"(A) shall be shown both agency-by-agency and
7	for all agencies; and
8	"(B) shall be accompanied by the corresponding
9	information (submitted by the Office in its report
10	under this subsection) for the fiscal year before the
11	fiscal year to which such report pertains, together
12	with appropriate comparisons and analyses.
13	"(4) For purposes of this subsection, the term 'offi-
14	cial time' means any period of time, regardless of agency
15	nomenclature—
16	"(A) which may be granted to an employee
17	under this chapter (including a collective bargaining

20	"(B) during which the employee would other-
21	wise be in a duty status.".
22	(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
