

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE

PRINT 117-8

OFFERED BY MS. ROSS OF NORTH CAROLINA

At the end of subtitle F of title I of division B, add the following:

1 **SEC. 1640. ELECTRIC VEHICLE WORKING GROUP.**

2 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF WORKING GROUP.—Not
3 later than 240 days after the date of enactment of this
4 Act, the Secretary of Transportation and the Secretary of
5 Energy shall jointly establish a working group consisting
6 of Federal and non-Federal stakeholders to make rec-
7 ommendations on the development, adoption, and integra-
8 tion of light and heavy duty electric vehicles into the trans-
9 portation and energy systems of the United States.

10 (b) MEMBERSHIP.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—The working group shall be
12 composed of—

13 (A) the Secretaries (or designees), who
14 shall be co-chairs of the working group; and

15 (B) relevant Federal and non-Federal
16 stakeholders, as determined by the Secretaries.

17 (2) REQUIREMENT.—The Secretaries shall en-
18 sure that the members of the working group include

1 individuals with a balance of backgrounds, experi-
2 ences, view points, and represent geographically di-
3 verse regions of the United States.

4 (c) MEETINGS.—The working group shall meet not
5 less frequently than once every 120 days.

6 (d) JOINT REPORT AND STRATEGY ON ELECTRIC
7 VEHICLE ADOPTION, OPPORTUNITIES, AND CHAL-
8 LENGES.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretaries, in consulta-
10 tion with the working group, shall submit to Con-
11 gress, a report on the status of electric vehicle adop-
12 tion, opportunities, and challenges to expanding
13 adoption of electric vehicles, and develop strategies
14 to address these opportunities and challenges.

15 (2) DEADLINES.—A joint report and strategy
16 shall be submitted to Congress by September 30,
17 2025.

18 (e) TERMINATION.—The working group shall termi-
19 nate on the date on which the report and strategy under
20 subsection (d) are submitted.
