Page 1032, after line 4, insert the following:

1	SEC PROHIBITIONS RELATED TO HUMAN TRAF-

3	Section 2(b) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
4	(12 U.S.C. 635(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
5	following:
6	"(14) Prohibitions related to human
7	TRAFFICKING AND RELIGIOUS FREEDOM.—
8	"(A) In General.—The Bank may not
9	guarantee, insure, or extend (or participate in
10	the extension of) credit in connection with the
11	purchase or lease of any product by a person in
12	a country—
13	"(i) to which the minimum standards
14	for the elimination of trafficking are appli-
15	cable, if the government of the country—
16	"(I) does not fully comply with
17	the standards; and
18	"(II) is not making significant
19	efforts to bring the country into com-

1	pliance with the standards, as deter-
2	mined in the most recent annual re-
3	port on trafficking in persons sub-
4	mitted under section 110(b)(1) of the
5	Trafficking Victims Protection Act of
6	2000; or
7	"(ii) that is designated as a country
8	of particular concern for religious freedom
9	by the President pursuant to section
10	402(b)(1)(A) of the International Freedom
11	Act of 1998, or recommended for that des-
12	ignation by the United States Commission
13	on International Religious Freedom.
14	"(B) Definitions.—In subparagraph (A):
15	"(i) Minimum standards for the
16	ELIMINATION OF TRAFFICKING.—The term
17	'minimum standards for the elimination of
18	trafficking' means the standards set forth
19	in section 108 of the Trafficking Victims
20	Protection Act of 2000.
21	"(ii) Country of Particular con-
22	CERN FOR RELIGIOUS FREEDOM.—The
23	term 'country of particular concern' means
24	a country that has engaged in or tolerated
25	particularly severe violations of religious

1	freedom in the country during the pre-
2	ceding 12 months or since the date of the
3	last review of the country pursuant to sec-
4	tion 402(b)(1)(A) of the International
5	Freedom Act of 1998, whichever period is
6	longer.".
