

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT

OFFERED BY MR. ROUZER OF NORTH CAROLINA

Page 250, strike lines 10 through 12, and insert the following:

1 (f) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 1 year after
2 receiving recommendations outlined in the report under
3 subsection (b), the Administrator shall take such action,
4 as appropriate, to implement those recommendations.

At the end of subtitle C of title III, add the following:

5 **SEC. ____ . MEDICAL PORTAL MODERNIZATION TASK**
6 **GROUP.**

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 120 days after
8 the working group pursuant to section 328 of this Act is
9 established, the co-chairs of such working group shall es-
10 tablish a medical portal modernization task group (re-
11 ferred to in this subsection as the “task group”) to evalu-
12 ate the user interface and information sharing capabilities
13 of an online medical portal administered by the Federal
14 Aviation Administration.

1 (b) COMPOSITION.—The co-chairs of the working
2 group provided for in section 328 shall appoint—

3 (1) a Chair of the task group; and

4 (2) members of the task group from among the
5 members of the working group appointed by the Ad-
6 ministrator under section 328(b)

7 (c) ASSESSMENT; RECOMMENDATIONS.—The task
8 group shall, at a minimum, assess and evaluate the capa-
9 bilities of any such medical portal and provide rec-
10 ommendations to improve the following:

11 (1) The cyber security protections and protocols
12 of any such medical portal, including the secure ex-
13 change of health information and records between
14 Aviation Medical Examiners and pilots, or their des-
15 ignee, including the ability for an airman to submit
16 additional information requested by the Adminis-
17 trator.

18 (2) The status of an airman’s medical applica-
19 tion and the disclosure of how long an airman can
20 expect to wait for a final determination to be issued
21 by the Administrator.

22 (3) The disclosure of the name and contact in-
23 formation of the Administrator’s representative
24 managing an airman’s case so that an Aviation Med-
25 ical Examiner has a point of contact within the Ad-

1 ministration who is familiar with an airman's appli-
2 cation.

3 (d) CONSULTATION.—In carrying out the duties de-
4 scribed in subsection (c), the task group may consult cy-
5 bersecurity experts and individuals with a knowledge of
6 securing electronic health care transactions.

7 (e) REPORT.—Not later than 1 years after the date
8 of the establishment of the task group, the task group
9 shall submit to the Administrator, the Committee on
10 Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Rep-
11 resentatives, and the Committee on Commerce, Science,
12 and Transportation of the Senate a report detailing activi-
13 ties and recommendations of the task group.

14 (f) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 1 year after
15 receiving the report described in subsection (e), the Ad-
16 ministrator shall take such action as may be necessary to
17 implement recommendations of the task group to improve
18 any such medical portal.
