Page 23, insert after line 17 the following:

1 (d) MEMBER ACCESS TO THE FOREIGN INTEL-  
2 LIGENCE SURVEILLANCE COURT AND FOREIGN INTEL-  
3 LIGENCE SURVEILLANCE COURT OF REVIEW.—The chair  
4 and ranking minority member of each of the congressional  
5 intelligence committees, the chairs and ranking members  
6 of the Committees on the Judiciary of the House of Rep-  
7 resentatives and of the Senate, the Majority and Minority  
8 Leaders of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Rep-  
9 resentatives, and the Minority Leader of the House of  
10 Representatives shall be entitled to attend any proceeding  
11 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court or any pro-  
12 ceeding of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court of  
13 Review. Each person entitled to attend a proceeding pur-  
14 suant to this paragraph may designate not more than 2  
15 staff members of such committee or office to attend on  
16 their behalf, pursuant to such procedures as the Attorney  
17 General, in consultation with the Director of National In-  
18 telligence may establish.

Page 45, strike line 16 and all that follows through line 17, and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 11. ANNUAL REPORT OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF IN-**  
2 **VESTIGATION AND QUARTERLY REPORT TO**  
3 **CONGRESS.**

Page 48, line 14, insert after “the report.” the following:

4 “(3) QUARTERLY REPORT.—Beginning on the  
5 date that is not later than 1 year after the effective  
6 date of this paragraph, the Director of the Federal  
7 Bureau of Investigation shall submit a quarterly re-  
8 port to the congressional intelligence committees and  
9 to the Committees on the Judiciary of the House of  
10 Representatives and of the Senate that includes the  
11 number of U.S. person queries conducted during  
12 that quarter.”.
