Add at the end of title IV, the following:

1                   **Subtitle D—Reports**

2   **SEC. 431. ANNUAL DEFENSE MANPOWER PROFILE REPORT:**  
3                   **EXPANSION OF JUSTIFICATIONS FOR END**  
4                   **STRENGTHS.**

5       Section 115a of title 10, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7           (1) in subsection (a), by striking “Congress”  
8       and inserting “to the Committees on Armed Services  
9       of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and  
10      furnish to any Member of Congress upon request,”;  
11      and

12           (2) in subsection (b)—

13           (A) by inserting “(1)” before “The Sec-  
14      retary”; and

15           (B) by adding at the end the following new  
16      paragraph:

17      “(2) The justification and explanation required by  
18      paragraph (1) shall include the following:

1           “(A) An assessment of the most important  
2           threats facing the United States, disaggregated by  
3           geographic combatant command.

4           “(B) An explanation of how personnel end  
5           strength level requests address threats described in  
6           subparagraph (A).

7           “(C) The rationale for recommended increases  
8           or decreases in active, reserve, and civilian personnel  
9           for each component of the Department of Defense.

10          “(D) The rationale for recommended increases  
11          or decreases in active, reserve, and civilian personnel  
12          for each of the geographic combatant commands.

13          “(E) The primary functions or missions of ac-  
14          tive, reserve, and civilian personnel in each geo-  
15          graphic combatant command.

16          “(F) An assessment of any areas in which de-  
17          creases in active, reserve, or civilian personnel would  
18          not result in a decrease in readiness.

19          “(G) The actual end strength number for each  
20          armed force for the prior fiscal year, compared to  
21          authorized end strength levels.

22          “(H) The shortfall in recruiting by each armed  
23          force as a percentage, as the Secretary determines  
24          appropriate.

1           “(I) The number of applicants who were found  
2           to be ineligible for service in the Department of De-  
3           fense during the prior fiscal year as a result of cur-  
4           rent enlistment standards, disaggregated by armed  
5           force and reason for disqualification.”.
