Insert at the appropriate place the following:

1 **SEC. 7. REQUIRING PROTECTION OF STUDENTS AND APPLI-**  
2 **CANTS UNDER CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS.**

3 Section 3008 (sec. 38-1853.08, D.C. Official Code)  
4 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
5 section:

6 “(i) REQUIRING PROTECTION OF STUDENTS AND AP-  
7 PPLICANTS UNDER CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS.—In addition to  
8 meeting the requirements of subsection (a), an eligible en-  
9 tity or a school may not participate in the opportunity  
10 scholarship program under this division unless the eligible  
11 entity or school certifies to the Secretary that the eligible  
12 entity or school will provide each student who applies for  
13 or receives an opportunity scholarship under this division  
14 with all of the protections that are applicable to a public  
15 school student and available under each of the following  
16 laws:

17 “(1) Title IV of the Civil Rights Act of 1964  
18 (42 U.S.C. 2000c et seq.).

19 “(2) Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964  
20 (42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq.).

1           “(3) Title IX of the Education Amendments  
2 Act of 1972 (20 U.S.C. 1681 et seq.).

3           “(4) The Equal Educational Opportunities Act  
4 of 1974 (20 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.).

5           “(5) The Individuals With Disabilities Edu-  
6 cation Act (20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.).

7           “(6) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of  
8 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794).

9           “(7) The Age Discrimination Act of 1975 (42  
10 U.S.C. 6101 et seq.).

11           “(8) Titles II and III of the Americans with  
12 Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12131 et seq.,  
13 12181 et seq.).”.
