At the end of subtitle G of title V, insert the following:

1	SEC. 5 OUTREACH TO MEMBERS REGARDING POSSIBLE
2	TOXIC EXPOSURE.
3	(a) Establishment.—Not later than 180 days after
4	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
5	Defense, in consultation with the Secretary of Veterans
6	Affairs, shall establish—
7	(1) a new risk assessment for toxic exposure for
8	members of the Armed Forces assigned to work near
9	burn pits; and
10	(2) an outreach program to inform such mem-
11	bers regarding such toxic exposure. Such program
12	shall include information regarding benefits and sup-
13	port programs furnished by the Secretary (including
14	eligibility requirements and timelines) regarding
15	toxic exposure.
16	(b) Promotion.—The Secretary shall promote the
17	program to members described in subsection (a) by direct
18	mail, email, text messaging, and social media.

1	(c) Publication.—Not later than one year after the
2	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall pub-
3	lish on a website of the Department of Defense a list of
4	resources furnished by the Secretary for—
5	(1) members and veterans who experienced
6	toxic exposure in the course of serving as a member
7	of the Armed Forces;
8	(2) dependents and caregivers of such members
9	and veterans; and
10	(3) survivors of such members and veterans
11	who receive death benefits under laws administered
12	by the Secretary.
13	(d) Toxic Exposure Defined.—In this section, the
14	term "toxic exposure" has the meaning given such term
15	in section 631 of the Jeff Miller and Richard Blumenthal
16	Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of
17	2016 (Public Law 114–315; 38 U.S.C. 1116 note).
