AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4366, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. RYAN OF NEW YORK

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1	Sec (a) Congress finds that—
2	(1) on July 9, 2023, the Hudson Valley region
3	and southeastern New York were struck by as much
4	as 8 inches of torrential rainfall that washed away
5	homes, roads, and businesses;
6	(2) Orange County, New York, home to the
7	United States Military Academy at West Point, was
8	hit particularly hard with initial damage assessments
9	revealing extensive flood damage, including washed
10	out roads, collapsed cliffside routes, and extensive
11	damage to barracks, bridges, and facilities critical to
12	the carrying out of the mission of the United States
13	Military Academy;
14	(3) the Directorate of Public Works of the
15	United States Military Academy and United States
16	Army Corp of Engineers continue to assess and pre-
17	pare estimates, with the most recent estimate of
18	damages being approximately \$103,000,000 and in-
19	creasing; and

1	(4) the facilities affected by such flood damage
2	are of a mission critical nature with regard to the
3	development of future leaders in the Armed Forces.
4	(b) It is the sense of Congress that—
5	(1) all facilities and infrastructure of the
6	United States Military Academy and the commu-
7	nities near the United States Military Academy that
8	were affected by flood damage related to rainfall on
9	July 9, 2023, should be rebuilt; and
10	(2) the Federal Government should, to the ex-
11	tent possible, assist with such efforts to rebuild.
