At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

- 10 by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
- 11 (b) COVERED PRODUCT DEFINED.—In this section,
- 12 the term "covered product" has the meaning given such
- 13 term in section 321 of the Energy Policy and Conservation
- 14 Act (42 U.S.C. 6291).
