At the end of subtitle C of title V insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 5____. POSTHUMOUS COMMISSION AS CAPTAIN IN THE 2 REGULAR ARMY FOR MILTON HOLLAND.

3 (a) POSTHUMOUS COMMISSION.—Milton Holland, 4 who, while sergeant major of the 5th Regiment, United 5 States Colored Infantry, was awarded the Medal of Honor in recognition of his action on September 29, 1864, during 6 7 the Battle of Chapin's Farm, Virginia, when, as the citation for the medal states, he "took command of Company 8 9 C, after all the officers had been killed or wounded, and gallantly led it", shall be deemed for all purposes to have 10 11 held the grade of captain in the regular Army, effective 12 as of that date and continuing until his separation from 13 the Army.

(b) PROHIBITION OF BENEFITS.—Section 1523 of
15 title 10, United States Code, applies in the case of the
posthumous commission described in subsection (a).
