

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-40

OFFERED BY MR. ROSENDALE OF MONTANA

At the end of the bill (before the short title) insert the following:

No funds made available through this Act shall be used for assisted reproductive technology that includes any infertility treatments or technologies that—

(1) places a fertilized egg, a blastocyst, or an embryo in a non-human alternative gestation environment such as an artificial womb or another form of complete ectogenesis;

(2) genetically modifies human DNA, any human cell, or a gamete into an egg or sperm (of which this genetic material was previously not) for the purpose of fertilization and conception in an infertility treatment such as occurs in in vitro gametogenesis; or

(3) uses preimplantation genetic testing, or another form of genetic diagnosis, to select an embryo based on its health, sex, physical features, potential IQ, or genetic profile.
