

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1231, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. RUNYAN OF NEW JERSEY**

Page 3, after line 25, insert the following (and re-designate accordingly):

1 “(B)(i) The Secretary shall not make available
2 for leasing under an oil and gas leasing program
3 under this section any area of the outer Continental
4 Shelf within the offshore administrative boundaries
5 of a State, if the Governor of the State certifies to
6 the Secretary that the voters of that State dis-
7 approved lease sales for the period of that program
8 for that area in a referendum conducted in accord-
9 ance with the laws of the State.

10 “(ii) A certification of a Governor and a ref-
11 erendum referred to clause (i) and shall apply for
12 purposes of this subparagraph only with respect to
13 one 5-year oil and gas leasing program under this
14 section.

15 “(iii) In this subparagraph the term ‘offshore
16 administrative boundaries’ means the boundaries de-
17 picted with respect to a State on—

18 “(I) the Bureau of Ocean Energy, Man-
19 agement, and Enforcement map entitled ‘Atlan-

1 tic NAD 83 Federal Outer Continental Shelf
2 (OCS) Administrative boundaries’, dated Janu-
3 ary 2010;

4 “ (II) the Bureau of Ocean Energy, Man-
5 agement, and Enforcement map entitled ‘Gulf
6 of Mexico NAD 27 Federal Outer Continental
7 Shelf (OCS) Administrative boundaries’, dated
8 January 2010; or

9 “ (III) the Bureau of Ocean Energy, Man-
10 agement, and Enforcement map entitled ‘Pa-
11 cific NAD 83 Federal Outer Continental Shelf
12 (OCS) Administrative boundaries’, dated Janu-
13 ary 2010.
