OFFERED BY MR. SABLAN OF NORTHERN
MARIANA ISLANDS

Add at the end of title II the following:

1 **SEC. 212. ELIMINATION OF GENERAL MEDICAID FUNDING**
2 **LIMITATIONS (“CAP”) FOR TERRITORIES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1108 of the Social Secu-
4 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1308) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (f), in the matter preceding
6 paragraph (1), by striking “subsection (g)” and in-
7 serting “subsections (g) and (h)”;

8 (2) in subsection (g)(2), in the matter pre-
9 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “and para-
10 graphs (3) and (5)” and inserting “, paragraphs (3)
11 and (5), and subsection (h)”;

12 (3) by inserting after subsection (g) the fol-
13 lowing new subsection:

14 “(h) SUNSET OF MEDICAID FUNDING LIMITA-
15 TIONS.—Subsections (f) and (g) shall not apply to Puerto
16 Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, the Northern Mariana Is-
17 lands, and American Samoa beginning with fiscal year
18 2020.”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

2 (1) Section 1902(j) of the Social Security Act
3 (42 U.S.C. 1396a(j)) is amended by striking “, the
4 limitation in section 1108(f),”.

5 (2) Section 1903(u) of the Social Security Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 1396b(u)) is amended by striking para-
7 graph (4).

8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 this section shall apply beginning with fiscal year 2020.
