MARIANA ISLANDS

At the end of division H, add the following:

1SECTION 40002. APPORTIONMENT UNDER PITTMAN-ROB-2ERTSON WILDLIFE RESTORATION ACT.

3 (a) Equivalent Minimum Apportionment Among 4 STATES AND TERRITORIES OF TAX REVENUES ACCRUING 5 TO FUND.—The first subsection (c) of section 4 of the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 6 669c), relating to apportionment of certain revenues ac-7 cruing to the fund, is amended by striking "among the 8 9 States" and all that follows through the end of the first sentence and inserting: "among the States and each of 10 11 American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands in pro-12 13 portion to the ratio that the population of each State and each such territory bears to the population of all the 14 15 States and such territories, except that each State shall be apportioned not more than 3 percent of such revenues, 16 and each State and each such territory shall be appor-17 tioned not less than 1 percent of such revenues.". 18

1 (b) Apportionment of Wildlife Conservation 2 AND RESTORATION ACCOUNT AMONG TERRITORIES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.—The second subsection (c) 3 4 of section 4 of the Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 669c), as added by section 902(e) of H.R. 5 6 5548, as introduced in the 106th Congress and enacted 7 into law by section 1(a)(2) of Public Law 106-55, and 8 relating to apportionment of the Wildlife Conservation and 9 Restoration Account, is amended by striking paragraph 10 (1) and inserting the following:

"(1) The Secretary of the Interior shall apportion from the Wildlife Conservation and Restoration
Account to each of the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands,
Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands a
sum equal to not more than one-half of 1 percent of
such Account.".

(c) REPEAL OF PERCENTAGE RESTRICTIONS ON APPORTIONMENTS TO TERRITORIES.—Section 8A of the
Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act (16 U.S.C.
669g-1) is amended by striking "as he shall determine,
not exceeding" and all that follows through ", in any one
year," and inserting "as the Secretary shall determine for
each year,".
