

AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
117-54
OFFERED BY MS. SALAZAR OF FLORIDA

Add at the end of subtitle E of title VIII the following new section:

1 **SEC. 8__ . MODIFICATIONS TO THE NONMANUFACTURER**
2 **RULE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8(a)(17) of the Small
4 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(a)(17)) is amended by add-
5 ing at the end the following new subparagraphs:

6 “(D) DENIALS.—Upon denial of a waiver under
7 subparagraph (B)(iv)(I), the Administrator shall
8 provide a justification of such denial, and if appro-
9 priate, make recommendations (including examples)
10 for resubmitting a request for a waiver.

11 “(E) INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR GRANTED
12 WAIVERS.—A waiver granted under subparagraph
13 (B)(iv)(I) shall include the following information:

14 “(i) The date on which the waiver termi-
15 nates.

16 “(ii) A statement specifying that the con-
17 tract to supply any product for which the wai-

1 er was granted must be awarded prior to the
2 termination date in clause (i).

3 “(iii) The total dollar value of the products
4 that are subject to the waiver.

5 “(iv) An exclusive list of specific products
6 identified by the Administrator that are subject
7 to the waiver, regardless of the determination of
8 the contracting officer submitted under such
9 subparagraph.

10 “(v) A list of actions taken by the con-
11 tracting Federal agency for which a new such
12 determination shall be required, including—

13 “(I) modifications to the scope of the
14 contract for which the waiver was granted;
15 and

16 “(II) modifications to the contract
17 type of such contract.

18 “(F) MODIFICATIONS.—If a Federal agency
19 modifies a contract for which a waiver was granted
20 under subparagraph (B)(iv)(I) in a manner de-
21 scribed in subparagraph (E)(v), the head of such
22 Federal agency shall notify the Administrator and
23 seek a new waiver under subparagraph (B)(iv)(I).”.

24 (b) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION AND PUBLICA-
25 TION.—Not later than 15 days after the date of the enact-

1 ment of this Act, the Administrator of the Small Business
2 Administration shall publish on a website of the Adminis-
3 tration and submit to the Committee on Small Business
4 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
5 Small Business and Entrepreneurship of the Senate any
6 program guidance or standard operating procedures of the
7 Administration relating to the process by which the Ad-
8 ministrator grants waivers under section
9 8(a)(17)(B)(iv)(I) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
10 637(a)(17)(B)(iv)(I)).
