(5) A description of U.S. Customs and Border 1 2 Protection programs or plans to reduce the number 3 of migrant deaths along the border, including a re-4 port of the frequency with which rescue beacons 5 were activated in the southern land border zone, including the number of migrants rescued by the Bor-6 7 der Patrol in a given year as the result of rescue 8 beacon activation and the number of beacons de-9 ployed per sector.

10 (6) A description of U.S. Customs and Border
11 Protection's procedures for responding to distress
12 calls from migrants, rescue beacon distress signals,
13 and missing persons reports from families of missing
14 migrants.
