At the end of subtitle B of title VII, add the following new section:

10 "(b) Additional Preventive HEALTH CARE SERVICES.—(1) In addition to the preventive services pro-11 12 vided under subsection (a), persons entitled to medical care under this chapter shall also be entitled, to the extent 13 14 practicable, to the coverage of preventive health services comparable to the coverage required to be provided by a 15 group health plan and a health insurance issuer offering 16 group or individual health insurance coverage under sec-17

tion 2713 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
 300gg-13). Such entitlement shall supersede any other wise applicable exclusions to the contrary.

4 "(2) Persons entitled to medical care under this chap5 ter shall also be entitled to other evidence-based preventive
6 health care services and screenings, as may be prescribed
7 in regulations by the Secretary of Defense.

8 "(3) The Secretary shall prescribe regulations to— 9 "(A) waive all copayments under sections 10 1074g, 1075, 1075a, 1079(b), and 1086(b) of this 11 title for preventive services provided pursuant to this 12 subsection for all beneficiaries who would otherwise 13 pay copayments; and

"(B) ensure that a beneficiary pays nothing for
such preventive services during a year without regard to whether the beneficiary has paid the amount
necessary to cover the beneficiary's deductible for
the year.".

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 1077(a) of
title 10, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
end the following new paragraph:

22 "(18) The additional preventive health services23 described in section 1074d(b) of this title.".

24 (c) EXPANDED WELL CHILD CARE AND ACCESS TO25 HEALTH PROMOTION AND DISEASE PREVENTION VIS-

1 ITS.—Section 1079(a)(2) of title 10, United States Code, is amended by striking "schedule of immunizations" and 2 3 all that follows through subparagraph (B) and inserting 4 "schedule of immunizations, health promotion and disease 5 prevention visits and immunizations (including the preventive care and screenings required pursuant to section 6 7 1074d(b) of this title) may be provided to dependents.". 8 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by 9 this section shall take effect on October 1, 2017. The Sec-10 retary of Defense may issue an interim final rule or take such other action as necessary to ensure implementation 11 12 of such amendments on such date.

13 (e) FUNDING MATTERS.—

14 (1) OFFSET.—Notwithstanding the amounts set 15 forth in the funding tables in division D, the amount 16 authorized to be appropriated in section 101 for pro-17 curement, Army, as specified in the corresponding 18 funding table in section 4101, for missile procure-19 ment, Army, the amount for TOW 2 System Sum-20 mary Advanced Procurement is hereby reduced by 21 \$10,000,000.

(2) INCREASE.—Notwithstanding the amounts
set forth in the funding tables in division D, the
amount authorized to be appropriated in section
1406 for the Defense Health Program, as specified

- 1 in the corresponding funding table in section 4501,
- 2 is hereby increased by \$9,000,000.
