At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

7	training program conducted by the Office of the Sergeant
8	at Arms consisting of the following:
9	(1) Training in fire safety methods and proce-
10	dures.
11	(2) Training in the proper use of fire alarms.
12	(3) Training in how to be protected in the event
13	of fire, including training in the principles of "stop,
14	drop, and roll".
15	(4) Training in how to recognize fire alarms
16	visually.
