

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**

**OFFERED BY MS. GARCIA OF TEXAS**

After section 553, insert the following (and redesignate the following sections accordingly):

1 **SEC. 554. ANNUAL TRAINING ON THE PREVENTION OF SEX-**  
2 **UAL ABUSE FOR STUDENTS IN THE JUNIOR**  
3 **RESERVE OFFICERS' TRAINING CORPS.**

4 Chapter 102 of title 10, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

6 **“§ 2037. Training on prevention of sexual abuse**

7 “(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary of Defense,  
8 acting through the Under Secretary of Defense for Per-  
9 sonnel and Readiness, shall establish training for students  
10 enrolled in the Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps  
11 regarding prevention of sexual abuse.

12 “(b) ELEMENTS.—The training established under  
13 this section shall—

14 “(1) be age-appropriate;

15 “(2) be evidence-based in polyvictimization re-  
16 search;

17 “(3) be comprehensive, including elements re-  
18 garding—

1 “(A) grooming;

2 “(B) bullying, including cyberbullying;

3 “(C) appropriate relationships and inter-  
4 actions between such students and instructors;

5 “(D) signs of inappropriate behavior be-  
6 tween adults and adolescents; and

7 “(E) digital abuse; and

8 “(4) provide such students with the contact in-  
9 formation of local resources through which a student  
10 may report alleged sexual abuse or receive treatment  
11 and support for such abuse.

12 “(c) PROVISION.—The Secretary shall ensure that  
13 each such student receives training established under this  
14 section—

15 “(1) from an entity other than an administrator  
16 or instructor of the Junior Reserve Officers’ Train-  
17 ing Corps; and

18 “(2) once each year.

19 “(d) METRICS.—The Secretary shall establish and  
20 maintain metrics regarding the effectiveness of the train-  
21 ing established under this section.

22 “(e) SEXUAL ABUSE DEFINED.—In this section, the  
23 term ‘sexual abuse’ means an offense covered by section

1 920, 920b, 920c, or 930 of this title (article 120, 120b,  
2 120c, or 130 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice).”.
