

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1540, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SCHIFF OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle C of title 9, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 923. REPORT ON TRAINING STANDARDS OF DEFENSE**
2 **INTELLIGENCE WORKFORCE.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense,
5 in consultation with the Director of National Intelligence,
6 shall submit to the Committee on Armed Services and the
7 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House
8 of Representatives and the Committee on Armed Services
9 and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate
10 a report on the training standards of the defense intel-
11 ligence workforce. Such report shall include—

12 (1) a description of existing training, education,
13 and professional development standards applied to
14 personnel of defense intelligence components;

15 (2) a plan to ensure that training, education,
16 and professional development standards are applied
17 equally to all personnel of the intelligence commu-
18 nity; and

1 (3) an assessment of the ability to implement a
2 certification program for personnel of the intel-
3 ligence community based on achievement of required
4 training, education, and professional development
5 standards.

6 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

7 (1) DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE COMPONENTS.—

8 The term “defense intelligence components”
9 means—

10 (A) the National Security Agency;

11 (B) the Defense Intelligence Agency;

12 (C) the National Geospatial-Intelligence
13 Agency;

14 (D) the National Reconnaissance Office;

15 (E) the intelligence elements of the Army,
16 the Navy, the Air Force, and the Marine Corps;
17 and

18 (F) other offices within the Department of
19 Defense for the collection of specialized national
20 intelligence through reconnaissance programs.

21 (2) DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE WORKFORCE.—

22 The term “defense intelligence workforce” means
23 the personnel of the defense intelligence components.

24 (3) INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY; NATIONAL IN-
25 TELLIGENCE.—The terms “intelligence community”

1 and “national intelligence” have the meaning given
2 such terms in section 3 of the National Security Act
3 of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 401a).
