## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 467, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. SCHIFF OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1	SEC. 7. ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR FIRST RESPONDER
2	FENTANYL SAFETY EDUCATION.
3	In addition to any other amounts made available,
4	there are authorized to be appropriated \$50,000, for each
5	of fiscal years 2023 through 2028, to the Secretary of
6	Health and Human Services, in consultation with the Di-
7	rector of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
8	to establish and carry out a public health education and
9	awareness campaign providing evidence-based information
10	to local law enforcement agencies regarding best practices
11	for first responders who come in contact with fentanyl or
12	an individual using fentanyl.
