1	SEC. 10007. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING THE GREAT
2	LAKES.
3	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
4	(1) The Great Lakes provide drinking water for
5	more than 30 million people.
6	(2) With Canada, the United States is obligated
7	to protect the Great Lakes under the authority of
8	the Great Lakes—St. Lawrence River Basin Water
9	Resources Compact, international treaties, and do-
10	mestic law.
11	(3) The Great Lakes are a major economic
12	driver for the regional economies of bordering
13	States.
14	(4) According to the National Oceanic and At-
15	mospheric Administration, the Great Lakes maritime
16	economy is estimated to support more than 311,000
17	jobs.
18	(5) According to the Department of Transpor-
19	tation, the Great Lakes support more than
20	\$35,000,000,000 in waterborne commerce annually.

- 1 (b) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
- 2 gress that, in light of the Great Lakes serving as a major
- 3 source of safe drinking water for 30,000,000 people and
- 4 a critical economic driver for the entire region, the Federal
- 5 Government should not allow the exploration, develop-
- 6 ment, or production of oil or natural gas in the Great
- 7 Lakes.
