

**AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-43
OFFERED BY MR. SCHNEIDER OF ILLINOIS**

Page 192, beginning on line 13, strike “subsection (f)” and insert “subsection (g)”.

Beginning on page 192, strike line 15 and all that follows through the end of line 6 on page 196.

Page 196, line 7, strike “(g) EVALUATIONS AND REPORTS” and insert “(f) EVALUATIONS”.

Page 199, after line 7, insert the following:

1 “(g) PERFORMANCE REPORTS AND REVIEWS.—

2 “(1) PERFORMANCE REPORTS.—

3 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not less frequently
4 than annually during each year of the grant pe-
5 riod, each eligible institution that receives a
6 grant under this section shall submit to the
7 Secretary a report on the performance out-
8 comes achieved by the institution and the pro-
9 grams funded with the grant.

10 “(B) ELEMENTS.—Each report under this
11 paragraph shall include the following informa-
12 tion:

1 “(i) The performance of individuals
2 participating in programs funded with the
3 grant with respect to each of the primary
4 indicators of performance for adults de-
5 scribed in section 116(b).

6 “(ii) The performance of the eligible
7 institution on the performance indicators
8 related to capacity building described in
9 subsection (d)(2)(M).

10 “(iii) Such other information as the
11 Secretary determines appropriate.

12 “(2) TEMPLATE.—The Secretary shall develop
13 a template for the performance reports under para-
14 graph (1) that shall be used by eligible institutions
15 for the preparation and submission of such reports.

16 “(3) PUBLICATION OF REPORTS.—The Sec-
17 retary shall make the reports received under para-
18 graph (1) available on a publicly accessible website
19 of the Department of Labor in transparent, linked,
20 open, and interoperable data formats.

21 “(4) REVIEW.—On an annual basis, the Sec-
22 retary shall review and evaluate each performance
23 report submitted by an eligible institution under
24 paragraph (1) to determine if the institution
25 achieved adequate levels of performance. If the Sec-

1 retary determines that an eligible institution did not
2 achieve adequate levels of performance, the Sec-
3 retary shall provide technical assistance to the insti-
4 tution.”.

Page 199, strike lines 8 through 20.

Page 199, line 21, strike “(i)” and insert “(h)”.

Page 201, line 11, strike “(j)” and insert “(i)”.

Page 201, line 16, strike “(k)” and insert “(j)”.
