**OFFERED BY MR. SCHNEIDER OF ILLINOIS**

Page 1348, insert after line 23 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

**1 SEC. 5806. REPORT ON EXTREMISM.**

2 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment  
3 of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall release a review  
4 of the risk of domestic extremist movements targeting  
5 service members for recruitment. The review shall include  
6 the following:

7 (1) **THREAT.**—An overview of domestic violent  
8 extremist movements, as assessed within the Office  
9 of the Director of National Intelligence assessment,  
10 “Domestic Violent Extremism Poses Heightened  
11 Threat in 2021”, including the tactics, techniques,  
12 and procedures by which the movements identified  
13 recruit service members, as well as current trends in  
14 such recruitment.

15 (2) **PERSONNEL ACTIONS.**—A detailed review of  
16 personnel actions pursuant to DoD Instruction  
17 1325.06 (“Handling Protest, Extremist, and Crimi-  
18 nal Gang Activities Among Members of the Armed

1 Forces”) for the period of January 2022 through  
2 February 2023.

3 (3) MITIGATING FACTORS.—A detailed review  
4 of measures taken to mitigate these threats, includ-  
5 ing military criminal investigations, personnel poli-  
6 cies, and training and education.

7 (4) FOREIGN ACTORS.—An overview of foreign  
8 adversarial actors suspected of taking advantage of  
9 domestic extremist movements to undermine the se-  
10 curity of the force by supporting these movements or  
11 seeking to degrade good order and discipline through  
12 extremist support as a strategic tactic.

13 The report shall be distributed, including classified an-  
14 nexes, to the Committee on Armed Services of the House  
15 of Representatives and to the Committee on Armed Serv-  
16 ices of the Senate. An unclassified version of the report  
17 shall be posted on the Department of Defense website con-  
18 currently to the classified version’s dissemination to Con-  
19 gressional committees. No version of the report shall in-  
20 clude personally identifiable information.
