AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115–70 OFFERED BY MR. SCHNEIDER OF ILLINOIS

At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 12 REPORT ON IRANIAN SUPPORT OF PROXY
2	FORCES IN SYRIA AND LEBANON.
3	(a) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4	of the enactment of this Act, the President shall submit
5	to Congress a report that describes Iranian support of
6	proxy forces in Syria and Lebanon and assesses the in-
7	creased threat posed to Israel, other United States re-
8	gional allies, and other specified interests of the United
9	States as a result of such support.
10	(b) Matters to Be Included.—The report re-
11	quired under subsection (a) shall include, at a minimum
12	information relating to the following matters with respect
13	to both the strategic and tactical implications for the
14	United States and its allies:
15	(1) A description of arms or related material
16	transferred by Iran to Hizballah since March 2011
17	including the number of such arms or related mate-
18	rial and whether such transfer was by land, sea, or

1	air, as well as financial and additional technological
2	capabilities transferred by Iran to Hizballah.
3	(2) A description of Iranian and Iranian-con-
4	trolled personnel, including Hizballah, Shiite mili-
5	tias, and Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps forces,
6	operating within Syria, including the number and
7	geographic distribution of such personnel operating
8	within 30 kilometers of the Israeli borders with
9	Syria and Lebanon.
10	(3) An assessment of Hizballah's operational
11	lessons learned based on its recent experiences in
12	Syria.
13	(4) A description of the threat posed to Israel
14	and other United States partners in the Middle East
15	by the transfer of arms or related material or other
16	support offered to Hizballah and other proxies from
17	Iran.
18	(e) Definition.—In this section, the term "arms or
19	related material" means—
20	(1) nuclear, biological, chemical, or radiological
21	weapons or materials or components of such weap-
22	ons;
23	(2) ballistic or cruise missile weapons or mate-
24	rials or components of such weapons;

1	(3) destabilizing numbers and types of ad-
2	vanced conventional weapons;
3	(4) defense articles or defense services, as those
4	terms are defined in paragraphs (3) and (4), respec-
5	tively, of section 47 of the Arms Export Control Act
6	(22 U.S.C. 2794);
7	(5) defense information, as that term is defined
8	in section 644 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961
9	(22 U.S.C. 2403); or
10	(6) items designated by the President for pur-
11	poses of the United States Munitions List under sec-
12	tion 38(a)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act (22
13	U.S.C. $2778(a)(1)$).
